While every piece of Accoya Color Grey is colored surface to core, ensuring high durability and low maintenance, please be aware the product may look lighter or darker depending on the batch of product, the natural wood characteristics and the environment the product is used in. All wood decking will require cleaning at least once a year. Fine cracks can appear on Accoya decking after installation and when it starts to weather. Cracks are a natural phenomenon on wood and have no effect on its durability.
